#### **ONLINE TRAINING DEADLINE NOV. 1**

As per the August newsletter, review of manual changes and first aid refresher is required for all CSP members returning to patrol in the 2020/20201 season.

#### **CLICK FOR STEP BY STEP GUIDE**

#### WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

- CSP regular members' current Advanced First Aid (AFA) certification has been extended by 12 months, to expire on December 31, 2021.
- There will be no zone recertification weekends, diagnostic, written or CPR exams for returning patrollers.
- Each returning patroller is required to complete the 2020-2021 e Learning training update modules and quizzes online.

#### **ONLINE TRAINING GUIDELINES:**

- Logon to: courses.edu.skipatrol.ca
- Your former login credentials should work on this new site.
   Use your CSP Membership ID (without the leading 0) and you may use the "forgot password" function if required.
- The online training and quizzes should take approximately two hours to complete. It will be tracked and should be completed by November 1, 2020.
- The quizzes must be corrected to 100 per cent, but correct answers are provided for subsequent attempts so it shouldn't be an issue.

For manual updates, the focus is now on the e Pub version, which is available on the NDS. Current changes will be incorporated directly into that document. National will maintain a PDF version for the time being, and will list current changes in an appendix with references to the main document.

## **OPTIONAL AFA REFRESH**

The Calgary Zone training team is offering refresher (practice) sessions to all returning patrollers.

Please note: these sessions are completely voluntary -- you are not required to attend in order to qualify to patrol.

There will be a number of skill stations, one of them being a highlevel overview of CSP pandemic protocols. There will be no testing, only guidance from instructors.
