Federal Accreditation

The CSP has been accredited by the Federal government to provide first aid training to the public since January of 2005.

What this means to an individual member is that the CSP training course has met all the federal requirements for accredited first aid training in the *workplace* as well as on the hill/trail.

In most provinces, this means that the first aid course provided by CSP can be recognized by the provincial health and safety regulatory bodies as sufficient for patrollers who need first aid training as a job requirement. A valid ID card identifies them as being qualified.

The current provincial exceptions are British Columbia and Newfoundland where patrollers are still required to take an occupational health and safety course to be considered for positions requiring workplace first aid.
